CLINICAL SETTING



King Abdulaziz University Hospital rhinology practice is a tertiary care academic rhinology practice. The most busy rhinology unit in the Saudi Arabia. Rhinology fellowship participants have the opportunity to integrate allergy evaluation and treatment into their clinical training during the fellowship years. Mentored surgical experience occurs in the inpatient operating rooms 2 days per week with extensive experience in routine FESS procedures. Outpatient clinic experience is scheduled approximately 2 days per week. This includes one half-day for Rhinology follow clinic.

RESEARCH SETTING

The fellow would participate in ongoing research projects in the Rhinology research chair. Research projects will have a heavier clinical or basic science emphasis, dependent upon the interests of each fellow and fellows are encouraged to present at national and international meetings and publish manuscripts in rhinology journals.
